Personnel – Certified

Prohibition on Recommendations for Psychotropic Drugs

CREC prohibits school personnel from recommending the use of psychotropic drugs for any child. For the purpose of this policy, the term "recommend" shall mean to directly or indirectly suggest that a child should use psychotropic drugs.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, school medical staff may:

- 1. recommend that a child be evaluated by an appropriate medical practitioner, OR
- 2. consult with appropriate medical practitioners with the consent of the parents and/or guardians of a child.

Nothing in this policy shall be construed to prohibit a Planning and Placement Team from discussing with parents the appropriateness of consultation with, or evaluation by, medical practitioners.
