School District Legal Status

The Capitol Region Education Council is a Regional Educational Service Center (RESC) established under CT General Statute 10-66 a-n. Through this legislation, Connecticut permits local boards of education to establish a RESC as a “public educational authority” for the purpose of “cooperative action to furnish programs and services.” Such intermediate units that are smaller than a State Educational Agency (SEA), but larger than a Local Educational Agency (LEA) – are used as service delivery mechanisms in more than 75 percent of the states.
