Children with autism are increasingly being included in the general education setting; however, they are so often excluded from meaningful language experiences and early literacy instruction. This workshop provides a framework for increasing qualitative, natural language, and literacy learning experiences in the general education setting for children who have autism. Children with autism need natural contexts for learning and using language and literacy.

Participants will examine processes for planning instruction, creating materials and engineering the early childhood classroom to be used as an effective teaching tool. Participants will learn tips for implementing and embedding evidence based strategies to providing qualitative early learning experiences for ALL children in the general education classroom.

This workshop is intended for general education teachers, special education teachers speech language pathologists and paraprofessionals who work with children in the preschool and kindergarten setting.
