AARC Qualifications

- A current teacher certification in an approved area, such as elementary education or math
- Three years of teaching experience (substitute time will be considered)
- A desire to work with students who have disabilities

AARC Advantages

- Flexible classes, including summer, Saturday, and online
- Job-embedded portfolio assignments
- Designed for working professionals (14 month program)
- Opportunity to participate in a cohort with a regional mentor
