## **Facilitated Online Mentor Update**

**October 24, 2017**

**9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.**

**Cost: \$50**

This facilitated conversation is designed to provide participants with an opportunity to engage in discussion to deepen their understanding and learn from their colleagues, while completing the on-line mentor update training. Participants will be able to: Explain the similarities and differences between the TEAM Planning Module and the Modules for Classroom Environment, Instruction, and Assessment; Recognize and use appropriate coaching questions to help beginning teachers think more deeply about their planning decisions, and the potential impact on students, prior to teaching; Compare beginning teachers' words, actions, and products over time to help create an accurate picture of professional growth, as evidenced by the development of new learning improvements in teaching practice and outcomes for students; and Demonstrate how beginning teachers' participation in TEAM can support their participation in the district evaluation process.

## **Facilitated Online Reviewer Update**

**October 25, 2017**

**Cost: \$50**

Participants are given multiple opportunities to read and review a range of papers to assist them in making informed decisions.

## **Beginning Teacher Support Session**

This session is designed to deepen understanding of the expectations of the module process. Participants will be able to: Communicate the high standards for teaching and learning established for CT Public Schools; Develop the skills of reflection and analysis about teaching; Review and discuss TEAM Timeline/Module Process; and Provide explicit examples that support new learning, impact on practice, and impact on students.

## **Facilitated Module 5 Conversation**

**April 3, 2018**

This is a 90 minute facilitated scenario-based discussion designed to raise awareness of ethical and professional dilemmas in education. Participants will be able to: Discuss professional obligations and the potential consequences of misconduct; Communicate the guiding principles and standards of the teaching profession; Determine a favorable course of action when involved in competing priorities and responsibilities; and Use professional judgments and behavior that follow the spirit and the letter of the law, consistent with the district's goals, values and principles, and the Code of Professional Responsibility for Educators.
