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The Raising Readers Parent Club (RRPC) facilitator training is perfect for anyone working with parents of young children (birth to grade 3). Participants will be trained to lead clubs that encourage literacy and learning activities in the home.

What will participants gain as a result of this two-day training?

- Become a certified Raising Readers Parent Club facilitator
- Explore family literacy and adult learning concepts and research
- Participate in and facilitate mock club session
- Explore children's books and have opportunities to acquire free books
- Develop a plan to implement Raising Readers Clubs

What is a RRPC?

Raising Readers Parent Clubs consist of eight facilitated sessions, each focusing on a different literacy topic. RRPCs encourage parents to become more skillful and confident when reading to their children. It also encourages them to read daily, use family learning activities in the home, and incorporate library visits into the family routine.

Why are RRPCs important?

Our research shows that parents who participate in the RRPCs are more likely to get library cards for themselves and their children, identify their child's favorite book, and give books as gifts.
