IX. LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Patrice McCarthy talked about the House and Senate being in session, 2 reappointments to the State Board of Education and 3 new appointments to same. Education bills are not ready for action in either Chamber. Session will adjourn on 5/8/2024 and there will be a legislative wrap-up on 5/15.

Deb Borrero talked about permanent funding for education bills, the Teacher Residency Program and funding for trauma coordinators. She is monitoring session for various goals, especially large education bills.

X. **REPORTS**

A. 2023 – 2024 Financial Report (Attachment T)

As of our last council meeting the 2023-24 total approved budgets was \$435 million dollars of which \$600,000 was for school construction projects. That leaves a balance of \$434.4 million dollars.

With today's approval of the consent agenda, there is \$435 million dollars which excludes school construction.
